## CONSULTANT HAILS FUTMINNA AS MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP ENDS

**T**he 2 day Strategic Management Workshop for Top Management staff of Federal University of Technology, Minna has ended with active participation of Principal Officers, Deans, Directors and Heads of departments.

Speaking during the closing of the workshop, the Vice-Chancellor, Professor Muhammed Salihu Audu, said the forum was organized to enrich the knowledge of top level Management.

The Vice-Chancellor who was represented by the DVC (Academic) Professor Akim Osarhiemen Osunde expressed hope that knowledge gained at the workshop would be put into practice for the good of the University.

He disclosed that plans were on for an in-house workshop for officers on other levels of Management in the University.

He thanked JENCEL CONSULTS, presenters of the workshop, for a job well done.

Earlier, the Lead Consultant, JENCEL CONSULT Ltd, Professor Jude Njoku pointed out that many academics rise to top management level without

training in Management, hence the need to expose them to basic elements in University administration.

Professor Njoku who is a former Vice-Chancellor of the Federal University of Technology, Owerri observed that FUT, MINNA has a culture of discipline adding that he was impressed with the orderliness in the University.

Papers presented at the workshop were “Management Principles and Practice,” by Sir Richard Chioma, Project Coordinator World Bank Project on State Governance and Capacity Building, Imo State; “Administrative Management of a University,” by Dr. (Mrs.) Sally Asagwara, former Registrar, Michael Okpara University of Agriculture, Umudike, Abia State; “The Vice-Chancellor as Chief Executive of the University: Implications for University Administration,” and “Leadership Principles and Skills,” by Professor Jude Njoku as well as “The Committee System in University Administration,” by Mall. Muhammed Dattijo Usman, Registrar, FUT, MINNA.

Others were “Introduction to Financial Accounting”, by Mr. Mufutau Alabi Bello, Bursar, FUT, MINNA; “Effective Communication in the University,” by Mr. John Undelikwo, retired Deputy Director of Education and “Time and Stress Management,” by Engr. Dr. (Mrs.) Uche Dike, Deputy Director, FUTO CONSULTS Ltd.

Director, Advancement and Development Office, Professor Emmanuel Udensi who gave the vote of thanks said they are now better equipped with the workshop. He thanked Management for the workshop and promised that lessons learnt would be put into practice.

Over 70 top ranking officials of the University attended the workshop where presenters shared their rich and varied experiences with participants.

While welcoming the trainees to the University at the School of Engineering Workshop, Prof. Audu said they should consider themselves privileged to be selected out of so many that were screened from all over the federation. He urged them to make judicious use of the facilities in the University.

Speaking earlier at the occasion, the Director FUTMIN Ventures Ltd Dr. A. S. Ma'aji said the training will expose the trainees to hi-tech welding which can be useful in various sectors of the economy. He urged the welders to ensure they are found worthy in character and learning after the programme.

It would be recalled that FUT, Minna was selected as one of the seven centres in the country for the training which is practical and theoretical in nature. The training is expected to last for three months.

### **LIMIT OF NABTEB CERTIFICATES IN CAREER PROGRESSION**

It should be noted that NABTEB is a parastatal established by Decree 70 of 1993, to among other functions, conduct examinations leading to the award of National Technical Certificate (NTC), National Business Certificate (NBC), Advanced National Technical Certificate (ANTC) and Advanced National Business Certificate (ANBC) which replace all Technical and Business Examinations hitherto conducted by the Royal Society of Arts (RSA) of London, City and Guilds (C&G) of London Institute and the West African Examinations Council (WAEC).

From the foregoing, it is clear that NABTEB Certificates are relevant for purposes of career advancement of staff in the Craftsman/Technician/Technical cadre where the qualifications of the former City and Guilds of London, RSA and WAEC Technical were required. They are therefore, not relevant for purposes of career advancement in the Clerical and Executive Officer (General Duties) cadres.

The Management wishes to notify the University staff that henceforth, NABTEB Certificates/Statements of Result submitted by staff members that are not in Craftsman/Technician/Technical cadre will no longer be accepted for career progression.

The minimum entry requirement is five (5) O'Level (SSCE/NECO/GCE/NABTEB or other equivalent) credits at not more than two sittings including: English Language, Mathematics and Physics plus any other two from Sciences, Geography and Economics.

Applicants must have scored the JAMB minimum cut off point at Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME). However, candidates who meet the minimum O'Level requirement can also apply.

### Duration of Programmes

The minimum period is 10 academic semesters. Nevertheless, a candidate is free to work at his/her own pace towards graduation.
