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

FUT, MINNA HOLDS LEVEL ADVISERS WORKSHOP

A One day training workshop has been held for Academic Advisers/Counsellors of Federal University of Technology, Minna.

The workshop organized by the Quality Assurance and Productivity Unit, was held recently at the University Auditorium, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

Declaring the workshop open, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Muhammed Salihu Audu, FMAN, who was represented by the DVC (Academic), Prof. Akim Osarhiemen Osunde, said Federal University of Technology, Minna, aspires to be recognized as one of the top technology universities in the country and on the African continent, adding that this aspiration anchors on promotion of excellence in staff, students, academic and research facilities, as well as quality of community service.

Prof. Osunde noted that the essence of the workshop was to orientate staff members on the need to have positive attitude to work, and to acquaint academic level advisers and counsellors in the University with

their functions and responsibilities to students. This, he said, is in relation to the quality of students being produced and the overall productivity of the University.

He also said that only candidates who are fully qualified in terms of five credits in O' level subjects, including Mathematics and English, are admitted and would be guided in the new terrain of their educational life by the level advisers/counselors who would be their regular contacts.

The DVC urged the participants to listen attentively to the resource persons and apply the knowledge gained in their respective departments.

During the workshop, Heads of Units and Deans presented papers on the roles of the level academic advisers/counsellors.

Those in attendance were Director, Quality Assurance and Productivity Unit, Prof. Adai Ibrahim; Director, Academic Planning Unit, Prof. Bamidele Awojoyogbe; Dean, School of Environmental Technology, Prof. Oluwole Morenikeji and other members of the University staff.

PROCEDURE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF ANTI-PLAGIARISM POLICY

Management at its 64th meeting approved the following procedure for the implementation of the Anti-Plagiarism Policy:

1. Each Department is to compile the names and matriculation numbers of all graduating 500 level and Spillover as well as postgraduate (PGD, Master's and Ph.D.)

students currently writing project/thesis and send a copy of the list to the Bursar.

2. The students so listed are to be directed immediately to pay into the University's account in Skye Bank at Main Campus, Gidan Kwano as follows:

B.Tech.	N 500.00
PGD	₦1,000.00
M.Tech	₦2,000.00
Ph.D.	₦2,000.00

3. The payment teller from the bank should be converted into University receipt at the Bursary.
4. The project supervisors are to upload the names and e-mail addresses of such students in the TURNITIN website (See Chairman of Implementation Committee – Prof. Oluwole Morenikeji for the details).

To ensure the sustainability of the policy, henceforth, all students are required to submit soft copies of their projects alongside the required number of hard copies to their departments. They are also required to immediately forward the following to the Chairman, Implementation Committee:

- a. available soft copies of existing completed projects/theses;
- b. hard copies of past projects/theses (for the Implementation Committee to convert to soft copies);
- c. hard or soft copies of any written assignments/term papers/publications.

This is to enable the Committee build a database for the University.
