=> Reviewer # 1

The article has a good substance. However, the following observations should be addressed.

1. The methodology to achieve the objectives is not clearly written in the abstract. The abstract also fails to present any quantifiable Key Performance Index (KPI) and its associated quantifiable result. All the KPIs should be presented with their respective results.
2. Italicized all the "etc al" in the body of the article.
3. The system flow chart (Figure 1) should be redrawn to fix the process box containing "upload Readings through NodeMCU to ThingSpeak Server " directly under the process box containing "Activate Load Cell".
4. The acknowledgment section is not clear. Recast it to convey the desired information precisely and accurately.

=> Reviewer # 2

Figures 1-3, and 12 titles are best centralised.

There are two Figure 1 which appears to be Figures 1 and 3

What is STAR in Figure 1 (supposed Figure 3) flow chart? Do you mean Start?

In section 2.3, line 3, include reference(s) or motivation behind 30 seconds interval reading and not any other interval.

Section 3.0, in the first sentence, write s/system in full or remove /s.

In section 3.2, line 1, remove below. Figure 6 is enough for description of the diagram of interest. You may even add a sentence to it before the figure itself. To avoid one sentence paragraph.

In page 4 of 15, line 1, why the spacing after 3.1?

In page 6 of 15, Figure 9 is not above. Consider removing above and below for your figures when correctly numbered.

In page 9 of 15, I am not sure if the acknowledgement is correct. It appears this paper was submitted to a journal earlier on. Ensure that there is no conflict of interest between publishers of this work.

Reference (2) has odd line spacing than others.

Where is page 10-15 of 15? Are they references assumed to be okay?
